February 3, 2008 - California Primary Preferences

<b>Democrats</b>	<b>CA</b>
Clinton	47%
Obama	39%
Someone else	6%
Undecided	8%

Among men, Barack Obama is at 45% and Hillary Clinton is at 44%. Among women, Clinton is at 50% and Obama is at 34%. Clinton leads among white voters 50% to 38% and among Hispanic voters 57% to 23%. Obama leads among black voters 71% to 15%. 9% of likely Democratic primary voters in California say they would never vote for Clinton in the primary and 9% say they would never vote for Obama.

Sample Size: 600 completed telephone interviews among a random sample of likely Democratic primary voters living in California (503 Democrats and 97 independent voters).

Sample Dates: February 1-2, 2008

Margin of Error:  $\pm 4$  percentage points, 95% of the time, on questions where opinion is evenly split.

Question Wording:

If the 2008 Democratic presidential preference primary were being held today between (names rotated) Hillary Clinton and Barack Obama, for whom would you vote - Clinton, Obama, or someone else?

Would you say that you definitely plan to vote in the 2008 Democratic presidential primary, that you might vote in the 2008 Democratic presidential primary, or that you will probably not vote in the 2008 Democratic presidential primary?

McCain	32%
Paul	8%
Romney	33%
Someone else	2%
Undecided	9%

Mitt Romney leads among men with 33%, followed closely by John McCain at 31%, with 15% for

Mike Huckabee. Among women, Romney is at 34%, McCain 33%, and Huckabee 17%.

Sample Size: 600 completed telephone interviews among a random sample of likely Republican primary voters living in California (600 Republicans).

Sample Dates: February 1-2, 2008

Margin of Error:  $\pm 4$  percentage points, 95% of the time, on questions where opinion is evenly split.

Question Wording:

If the 2008 Republican presidential preference primary were being held today between (names rotated) Mike Huckabee, John McCain, Ron Paul, and Mitt Romney, for whom would you vote - Huckabee, McCain, Paul, Romney, or someone else?

Would you say that you definitely plan to vote in the 2008 Republican presidential primary, that you might vote in the 2008 Republican presidential primary, or that you will probably not vote in the 2008 Republican presidential primary?
