Democrats	TN
Clinton	59%
Obama	37%
Someone else	1%
Undecided	3%

Hillary Clinton leads Barack Obama among men 59% to 36% and she leads Obama among women 59% to 38%. Clinton leads Obama among white voters 72% to 23% and Obama leads Clinton among African American voters 81% to 16%.

Sample Size: 600 completed telephone interviews among a random sample of likely Democratic primary voters living in Tennessee (424 Democrats and 176 independents and Republicans).

Sample Dates: February 3-4, 2008

Margin of Error: ± 4 percentage points, 95% of the time, on questions where opinion is evenly split.

Question Wording:

If the 2008 Democratic presidential preference primary were being held today between (names rotated) Hillary Clinton and Barack Obama, for whom would you vote - Clinton, Obama, or someone else?

Would you say that you definitely plan to vote in the 2008 Democratic presidential primary, that you might vote in the 2008 Democratic presidential primary, or that you will probably not vote in the 2008 Democratic presidential primary?

Republicans	TN
Huckabee	36%
McCain	30%
Paul	1%
Romney	27%
Someone else	2%
Undecided	4%

Mike Huckabee leads among Republicans with 36%, followed by John McCain at 28% and Mitt Romney at 28%. Among independents and Democrats, it is Huckabee 35%, McCain 35%, and Romney 25%.

Sample Size: 600 completed telephone interviews among a random sample of likely Republican primary voters living in Tennessee (455 Republicans and 145 independents and Democrats).

Sample Dates: February 3-4, 2008

Margin of Error: ± 4 percentage points, 95% of the time, on questions where opinion is evenly split.

Question Wording:

If the 2008 Republican presidential preference primary were being held today between (names rotated) Mike Huckabee, John McCain, Ron Paul, and Mitt Romney, for whom would you vote - Huckabee, McCain, Paul, Romney, or someone else?

Would you say that you definitely plan to vote in the 2008 Republican presidential primary, that you might vote in the 2008 Republican presidential primary, or that you will probably not vote in the 2008 Republican presidential primary?
