Below are the results of a three-day poll in the state of New Jersey. Results are based on telephone interviews with 600 likely Republican primary voters and 600 likely Democratic primary voters in New Jersey, aged 18+, and conducted February 1-3, 2008. The margin of sampling error is  $\pm 4.5$  percentage points for each Party.

1. Who is your first choice for the Republican nomination in 2008?

(Republicans only)

John McCain 55%

Mitt Romney 25%

Mike Huckabee 10%

Ron Paul 4%

Undecided 6%

Jobs and the economy 24%

The war in Iraq 17%

Taxes 15%
